This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (17 February) and Trinity Sunday (30 May) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

Online registration closes at 3pm the previous day for weekday Masses, and 3pm on Saturday for the Vigil and Sunday Masses. Temperature check and other protocols apply. Please arrive AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE the start of Mass to avoid delay. Once Mass starts, the doors will be closed. For all other parish gatherings, functions or meetings, registration will be by the QR Code only using your phone. Thank you for your cooperation. IMPORTANT COVID UPDATE

As from Monday 29 March, there will no longer be a cap on numbers for Weddings and Funerals, meaning that up to 440 people may now attend in our church, the same as Mass. Also, singing will be allowed. Please Note: Because there is only a week's notice about this, we cannot arrange singing for Easter ceremonies in this short time. Music will be provided through the sound system. However, we will sing some of the parts of the Mass with people's responses.
