SAVE OUR GRAVES Recently the NSW State Government unilaterally announced that it would be taking over the management and oversight of all cemeteries and burials in the state from the Churches who have successfully and sensitively done this for the last 150 YEARS. No satisfactory reasons have been given, and all the churches have objected strongly to this, yet the government has simply ignored their unanimous advice and intends to now legislate this into law. The result will be an extra layer of costly government bureaucracy that will result in large increases to the cost of funerals (up to \$9,000.00) as the churches have always operated on a "not-for-profit" basis, however the new government bureaucracy will be run on a profit basis. But, even worse, this will now ignore religious sensitivities to burying the dead, which is a liturgical ritual and a work of mercy and compassion and faith. Today's feast with its emphasis on the total self-giving of Jesus in the Eucharist, challenges us as Christians as to what we bring to the Eucharistic celebration and join there with Jesus's offering? The answer is our lives as Christian disciples; our personal vocations and the stewardship we have exercised regarding them; and our individual contributions to the great work of restoring all things in Christ.

ATTENDENCE REGISTRATION All registration for Mass attendance is now by using Eventbrite on the Parish Website or by using the QR Code at the church entry with your mobile phone. Without doing this, entry will not be possible. Its best to use Eventbrite as QR code entry is only possible if seats are available. SO PLEASE REGISTER BEFOREHAND. Go to the parish website, <a href="www.olhcrosemeadow.org.au">www.olhcrosemeadow.org.au</a> and click the Register for Mass button. Follow the prompts to whichever Mass you want to attend and complete the details. Online registration closes at 3pm the previous day for weekday Masses, and 3pm on Saturday for the Vigil and Sunday Masses. Please arrive <a href="AT LEAST 15 MINUTES">AT LEAST 15 MINUTES</a> <a href="BEFORE">BEFORE</a> the start of Mass to avoid delay. Once Mass starts, the doors will be closed. For all other parish gatherings, functions or meetings, registration will be by the QR Code only using your phone. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### COVID PROTOCOLS AND RELATED MATTERS

- Gatherings for Religious Services including weddings and funerals is now *1 person per 2 square meter rule without any cap on numbers*. We can have up to 440 people in our church. The 1.5-meter social distancing between people should be maintained where possible. Where 1.5m social distancing cannot be maintained, a face mask is recommended.
- After Mass please take a disinfectant wipe (provided on each pew) to rub over surfaces where you have been sitting or come in contact with and place them in the bins provided as you leave. *Please wait until the priest has left the Sanctuary before wiping. Thank you.*
- HOTSPOTS: If you have attended any designated "Covid hotspot" you must immediately self-isolate for 14 days and get tested even if you
  have no symptoms.
- Since collection plates can no longer be used, please place your offerings for both first and second collections in the marked containers in
  the foyer. Thank you for your on-going financial support. We are 'paying our bills' but it has necessitated very careful budgeting and financial
  oversight. I am very conscious of the financial strain of many people, but I sincerely ask that you try, if you are able, to maintain your usual
  offering as without it we simply could not continue to operate. Again, thank you.
- I strongly encourage parishioners who currently give by envelope to consider changing to Direct Debit or Credit Card contributions to ensure the regular income of the parish continues. *Please contact the parish office to arrange this*.
- If you are not yet coming physically to Mass, please drop your Planned Giving Envelope into the secure letter box at the front entry to the Parish Office each week. Please don't forget the first collection for the sustenance of the clergy (as we still have to live too!) If using the letter box, place this in a separate envelope marked 'First Collection'. <u>Thank you</u>.
- If you are not in the Parish Financial System and would like to join to support the Parish, forms are available at the Foyer Notice Board, or
  contact the parish office. Thank you for your support.
