FATHER REGINALD WILSON It is with sadness, though blessed for him, I inform you that Fr Wilson died on Wednesday morning. I administered the Last Rites of the Church to him the previous Thursday. After discussion with the Archdiocese of Sydney, of which he was a priest, it has been agreed that he will have his Solemn Requiem Mass of Christian Burial here at Rosemeadow on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April at 10.30am. Though he has not been active now for many years, it was here that he ministered in the final years that he was able to, and many parishioners will fondly remember him as he filled in for me whenever I went away. Accordingly, I invite as many as possible to attend his Requiem Mass and to pray for the eternal repose of his soul. Entry will be by using the OR code at the foyer, and not by pre-registration on Eventbrite. Following the public Mass Fr. Wilson will be privately interred in the Priests section of Rookwood cemetery. Requiescat in Pace.

PLEASE NOTE The Parish Office will be closed this Wednesday until 1pm when it will reopen until 4pm.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION 2021 Confirmation will be celebrated on Saturday 12th June 2021. It is available to all children who are in Year 6 or above and have made their First Communion. If you wish your child to receive this Sacrament and have not already enrolled online via the parish website, you MUST attend the first lesson for this programme on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2021 commencing at 4.15pm. Children will participate in lessons in the St. Joachim Parish Hall. This is the last opportunity for you to enrol for 2021. You must bring a copy of your child's Baptism and Birth certificate with you to attach to the enrolment form. The programme fee of \$25 is also payable at the first lesson. NOTE: If you will be enrolling at the first lesson, please arrive at 3.45pm to the Parish Hall before the lesson to complete the paperwork. Thank you.

NEW RELICS I have obtained three new relics for the Reliquary Shrine. They are St. Therese of the Child Jesus, St. Maria Goretti, and St. Catherine Laboure- to whom Our Lord appeared and asked for the devotion of the Sacred Heart to be propagated throughout the world. She is commemorated in the stained-glass window in the Sacred Heart Chapel. The relics are on the second shelf.

**READERS** Last weekend we began once again reading from the pulpit. We will also commence the normal reading procedure as well with TWO READERS as previously. Please try not to touch the lectern and only the Lectionary to turn the page when reading. For the moment I will continue to read the General Intercessions.

**REQUEST PLEASE** May I kindly ask all parishioner's not to start wiping seats or leaving the church until after the priest has left the sanctuary by the side or rear door. It is becoming too distracting now and happening earlier and earlier, sometimes even before the final Blessing. Thank you.

PROJECT COMPASSION BOXES Please return these to the container at the Notice Board, or the parish office. Thank you.

EASTER WATER You are welcome to take some Easter Holy Water from the container near the Baptism Font. BYO bottle. Push the round button on the front to release water. Do not twist or turn tap please.

PASCHAL PRECEPT Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is to be done between Ash Wednesday (17 February) and Trinity Sunday (30 May) unless for a good reason it is done at another time during the year. All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.

YOUNG ADULTS As Catholics, prayer should be part of our journey in coming to know our creator. Fr. Chris Sarkis will be presenting a talk on prayer, with a focus on Scriptural Prayer, and the importance of prayer in our lives. It will be Tuesday 27 April at 7:30pm in the Joachim Hall (the old church), Demetrius Road, Rosemeadow. Please note entry is limited to the young adults, 18 - 35 years, only. Coffee/tea and biscuits will be provided, donations greatly appreciated. All are warmly invited to attend 6:30 pm Mass before the talk. QR code registration will be required for Mass and the Hall.

ATTENDENCE REGISTRATION All registration for Mass attendance is now by using Eventbrite on the Parish Website or by using the QR Code at the church entry with your mobile phone. Without doing this, entry will not be possible. It's best to use Eventbrite as QR code entry is only possible if seats are available. SO PLEASE REGISTER BEFOREHAND. Go to the parish website, www.olhcrosemeadow.org.au and click the Register for Mass button. Follow the prompts to whichever Mass you want to attend and complete the details. Online registration closes at 3pm the previous day for weekday Masses, and 3pm on Saturday for the Vigil and Sunday Masses. Please arrive AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE the start of Mass to avoid delay. Once Mass starts, the doors will be closed. For all other parish gatherings, functions or meetings, registration will be by the QR Code only using your phone. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### COVID PROTOCOLS AND RELATED MATTERS

- Gatherings for Religious Services including weddings and funerals is now 1 person per 2 square meter rule without any cap on numbers. We can have up to 440 people in our church. The 1.5-meter social distancing between people should be maintained where possible. Where 1.5m social distancing cannot be maintained, a face mask is recommended.
- After Mass please take a disinfectant wipe (provided on each pew) to rub over surfaces where you have been sitting or come in contact with and place them in the bins provided as you leave. Please wait until the priest has left the Sanctuary before wiping. Thank you.
- HOTSPOTS: If you have attended any designated "Covid hotspot" you must immediately self-isolate for 14 days and get tested even if you have no symptoms.
- Since collection plates can no longer be used, please place your offerings for both first and second collections in the marked containers in the foyer. Thank you for your ongoing financial support. We are 'paying our bills' but it has necessitated very careful budgeting and financial oversight. I am very conscious of the financial strain of many people, but I sincerely ask that you try, if you are able, to maintain your usual offering as without it we simply could not continue to operate. Again, thank you.
- ensure the regular income of the parish continues. Please contact the parish office to arrange this.
- If you are not yet coming physically to Mass, please drop your Planned Giving Envelope into the secure letter box at the front entry to the Parish Office each week. Please don't forget the first collection for the sustenance of the clergy (as we still have to live too!) If using the letter box, place this in a separate envelope marked 'First Collection". *Thank you*.
- If you are not in the Parish Financial System and would like to join to support the Parish, forms are available at the Foyer Notice Board, or contact the parish office. Thank you for your support.
